## MANIFESTO ABOUT SOCIAL SECTOR FINANCING

Being today the 70th anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and with the aim of defending them, in the International Association to Change The World we publish this Manifesto to increase the financing of the social sector.

In other documents, we have argued the need for the social sector to replace the declining public sector as soon as possible.

It is necessary to increase the financing of the social sector to make the transition as quickly as possible, in order to reduce the damage caused by the decline and resistance of the ruling minority to lose their privileges.

For this, part of the public money must be used for the social sector. For example:

- Assigning a percentage of GDP. The European Union is financed with 1% of the GDP of each member country. The same could be done with the social sector.
- Assigning a percentage of the collection or public expenditure.
- Each Ministry allocating a percentage of its expenses.

In any of the cases, that percentage should grow until the total replacement of the public sector.

Ban that the public sector subsidize / bribe non-profit organizations (NPOs) it is the essential, to prevent the social sector be systemically corrupt like institutions. Therefore, the money must be delivered to the social sector for it to distribute among the NPOs. The distribution criterion must take into account that the priority is to change the system, so that the assistance activities must be secondary. The model of the United Kingdom could serve as a reference.
